UTLA Report

Bruce Wright (UTLA Rep)

- UTLA Update (Mr. Wright):
 - Prop 2, which authorizes \$10 billion in general obligation bonds for repair, upgrade, and construction of facilities at K-12 public schools (including charter schools), community colleges, and career technical education programs, including for improvement of health and safety conditions and classroom upgrades, passed in California
 - What this means for us is statewide this will help school (ours included) facilities improve
 - At this time the race for District 3 School Board Member is still too close to call. But we will have an update soon!

Principal's Report

Principal Corner (Mrs. Desiderio):

- Last meeting it was reported we had extra funds, Mrs. Desiderio is looking into a P.E. program, the program would include
 - Coaches that would do circuits with the classes
 - With the size of our school we would need about 3 coaches
 - They would be onsite 2 days a week, and during this they would also help during recess time where they would be able to set up games for the kids or go over rules of games with the kids
 - Potential start of January if we get a quote and we have the funds for the program
