- Woody's Enrichment Program
 - o There is availability for more sign ups

- COVID Uptick

- UTLA Update (Mr. Wright):
 - Governance meeting will take place in September, so nothing to report yet
 - Scott Schmerelson is running for re-election in LAUSD District 3 Election
 - The district covers North Hills, North Hollywoood, Northridge, Porter Ranch, Mission Hills and Reseda
 - If you live in this district you may start getting phone calls regarding the election, and it's important to Vote in November
 - Scott Schmerelson is an amazing board director, and has been a teacher and principal, he is currently up against an opponent that is a very strong charter supporter.
 - Get informed and if you can vote!
- HERO Update (Luke Stiles):
 - Our goal this year is \$100,000
 - We have (so far) collected \$9,270
 - We have pledged \$14k
 - These numbers are different because of the installment plans we now have
 - It would be amazing if we could push for families to pledge at the Silver Level (\$250) and have
 100 % participation to help with the programs we offer for our kids
 - These programs (in the past) include:
 - Arts integration
 - Scoring Stories (where our child were setting music to stories)
 - Dance
 - Gardening
 - Drama
 - School Beautification
 - ANY donation truly helps
 - HERO is our largest fundraiser and the juiciest chunk of funds that we use for our school programs
 - We also like to give back to our community, with events like Movie Night last year. It was funded by PATT as a 'Thank You' for all the fundraising help throughout the year.
 - We are building a community outside of just school

- Spirit Wear Update (Janet Leger)
 - Every week there is Spirit Wear Wednesday
 - Families actively bought Spirit gear during Sneak Peek and Back to School Night
 - New Gear
 - Tote bag
 - PATT gifted the teachers and staff a tote that was filled with supplies
 - So happy to give back to our amazing staff that gives so much
 - Pajama Pants

- Hoping to get a PJ Day together later in the year
- At our Monthly Assembly (09/06/24) we will be selling Spirit Wear there and we still have our online shop too
- Fall Festival (Menije Turner)
 - o November 16th
 - Country Carnival
 - Get ready to pull out your finest cowboy hat, and boots!
 - We will have DJ Coby (from Sneak Peek and Glow Dance), games, bake sale, and spirit wear will be sold.
 - Silent Auction will also take place again
 - Volunteer Opportunity
 - This is our most permitted event, so maybe you can't help the day of, but maybe you can help leading up to the event, and there's a lot of help needed behind the scenes!
 - We do need help with permits
 - o This event is open to our community, so please share with your friends and family!
- Resilience Training (Dr. Kanchi)
 - This program was approved by LAUSD, in March 2024 for our 4th graders
 - This program had 10 sessions
 - Emotional regulation
 - Shift from negative thoughts
 - Growth mindset
 - How the brain works
 - Assertiveness training and how to deal with bullying
 - Mindfulness exercises
 - We are bringing this program back this year, again for our 4th graders
 - We are in the process of resubmitting with LAUSD for this new school year
- Room Parent Update (Monica Thomas)
 - Still communicating with the teacher and working on getting all the room parents settled
 - Monica has sent emails to the Room Parents that have been chosen already, and is working on with the teachers (that haven't chosen yet) to finalize
- 5th Grade (Charlotte McPherson)
 - Strategic planning meeting tomorrow (09/04/24)
 - So next meeting they will have more events and information for us
 - Currently fundraising through Venmo, and need the CheddarUp info
 - First restaurant night will be at The Stand, on 09/21/24
 - 25% of the proceeds will go back to the 5th grade
 - They are hoping to have an event at least once a month, and will be putting together a schedule

- Fund Photos (Amy Carter)
 - o Family photo shoot fundraiser
 - o This year instead of one date, there are a bunch of dates and different locations
 - \$50 for 15 minute photoshoot, and 2 photos included
 - any additional photos you are interested in, will be an additional cost
 - The full \$50 goes to PATT

Play Structures/ Sun Shade

- Mrs. Desiderio addressed this
- New apparatus' cost (roughly) around \$300,000, not cheap!
- District is not willing to upgrade because they just upgraded six years ago (before Mrs. Desiderio came)
- Sun shades also cost (roughly) around \$300,000, and the district is not inclined to help fund
 - Also there's many different people that get involved to get these things done
- The state makes it difficult
- Lower and Kinder yards
 - o The bottoms (the rubber matting) are getting replaced
 - District is paying for this
